Spend time in the shade when the sun is strongest. In the UK, this is between 11am and 3pm from March to October.

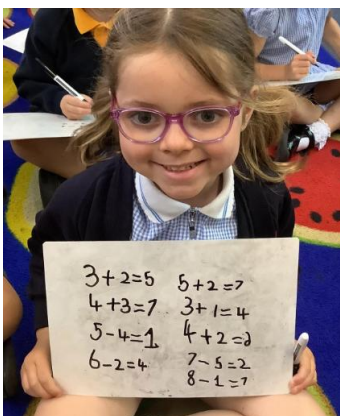
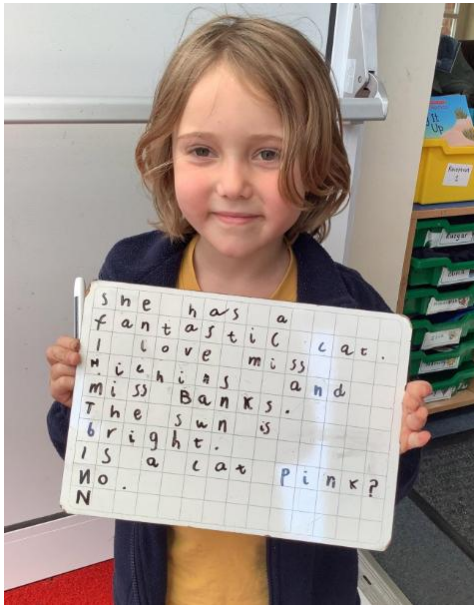
You can also check the UV index on a weather app or website. If it's 3 or higher, consider protecting your skin.

Make sure you:

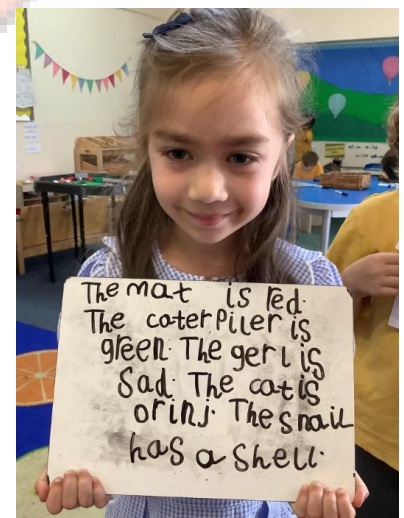
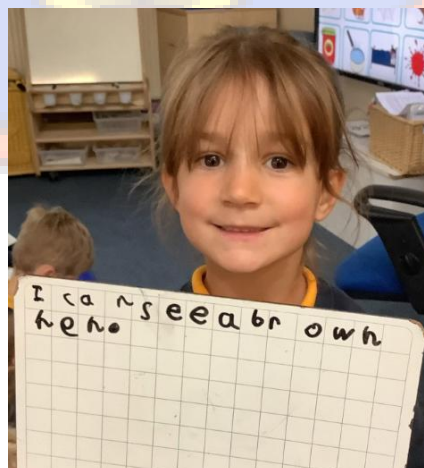
- spend time in the shade between 11am and 3pm

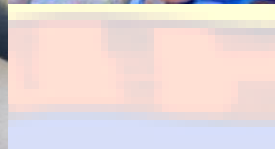

Community Governor Vacancy

Are you interested in being a Community Governor and supporting the on-going success of a local school?

We are looking to recruit a Community Governor to our School Standards Committee (formally known as the Local Governing Body) for Stratford-upon-Avon Primary School, which is part of Community Academies Trust.

We are looking for people who have the skill to act as a 'critical friend' asking challenging questions about performance and use their skills and experience to support the school in addressing its aims. You will be involved in creating and developing a strategic plan for the school, setting and agreeing objectives, and monitoring and evaluating the schools' success by focusing on progress and outcomes - within CAT, this is known as being 'Guardians of Standards'.

This is a voluntary position. If you are aged 18 or over and are able to commit around 10-15 hours per term to the role, which includes attending School Standards Committee meetings, pre-reading of associated papers, and associated school governance activities, we would love to hear from you.

You do not need to be a parent of a pupil at the school, only to live or work in the local community and be committed to the governance and success of the school. You do not need any prior governance experience – full training and support will be provided. What matters most is your commitment to the school and any transferable skills, professional insight, or lived experience you can bring that will strengthen our School Standards Committee. This is a highly rewarding role, offering the chance to make a real difference to children's lives and to support the ongoing success of our school.

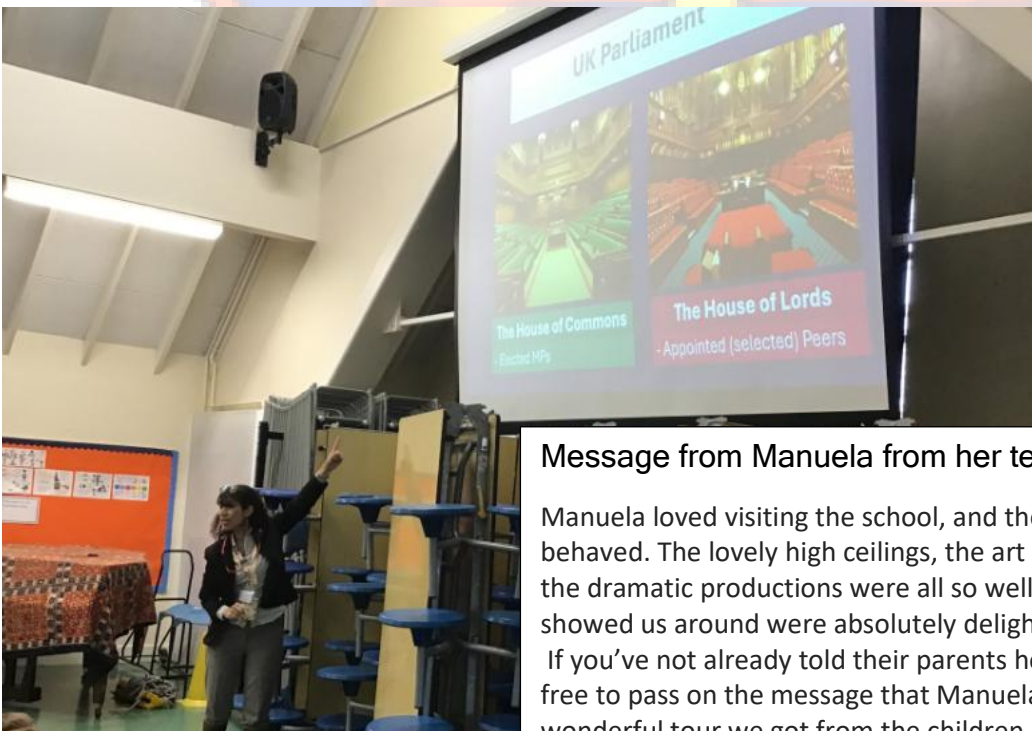
