Reception = 98.3% ↑ Year One = 96.7%=


Year Two = 94%↓ Year Three = 95.5%↓

The arrows indicate if the attendance is up or down from previous week.




SAFEGUARDING - IS EVERYONE'S RESPONSIBILITY


SHARENTING
